

'Spring Chicken' at Easter



Equipment needed

Scissors
Secateurs
Glue gun
Green wires 22swg
Parafilm
Knife

Contents

Dry foam brick
Natural moss
Twiggy container
Twigs from the garden
Bunch silk yellow tulips
Variegated ivy
Stem of silk forsythia
Mirror Glass chips
Chick in a nest
Ribbon to tone
Few wrapped chocolate eggs

Take a twiggy container, cut the dry foam brick to fit into the glass container inside the twiggy outer and push the foam down into it.

Cover the top and sides of foam with the moss.

Cut twigs to different lengths to add interest to the arrangement and push them into the foam towards the back of the container.

Add the tulips, using different heights to look natural.

Cut down the stem of the chick on the pick, and push into the foam at the front of the arrangement.

Stick little bits of mirror glass chips onto the twigs for a bit of sparkle.

Stick the forsythia flowers to the twigs.

Add the ivy to cover the moss base and hide the twig and tulip stems.

Wire or stick the chocolate eggs into the moss

Wrap a length of ribbon around the middle of the container and stick with the glue gun.

Make a bow out of the same ribbon, and attach with the glue gun.
